

Welcome to TerraTec Video Capture!

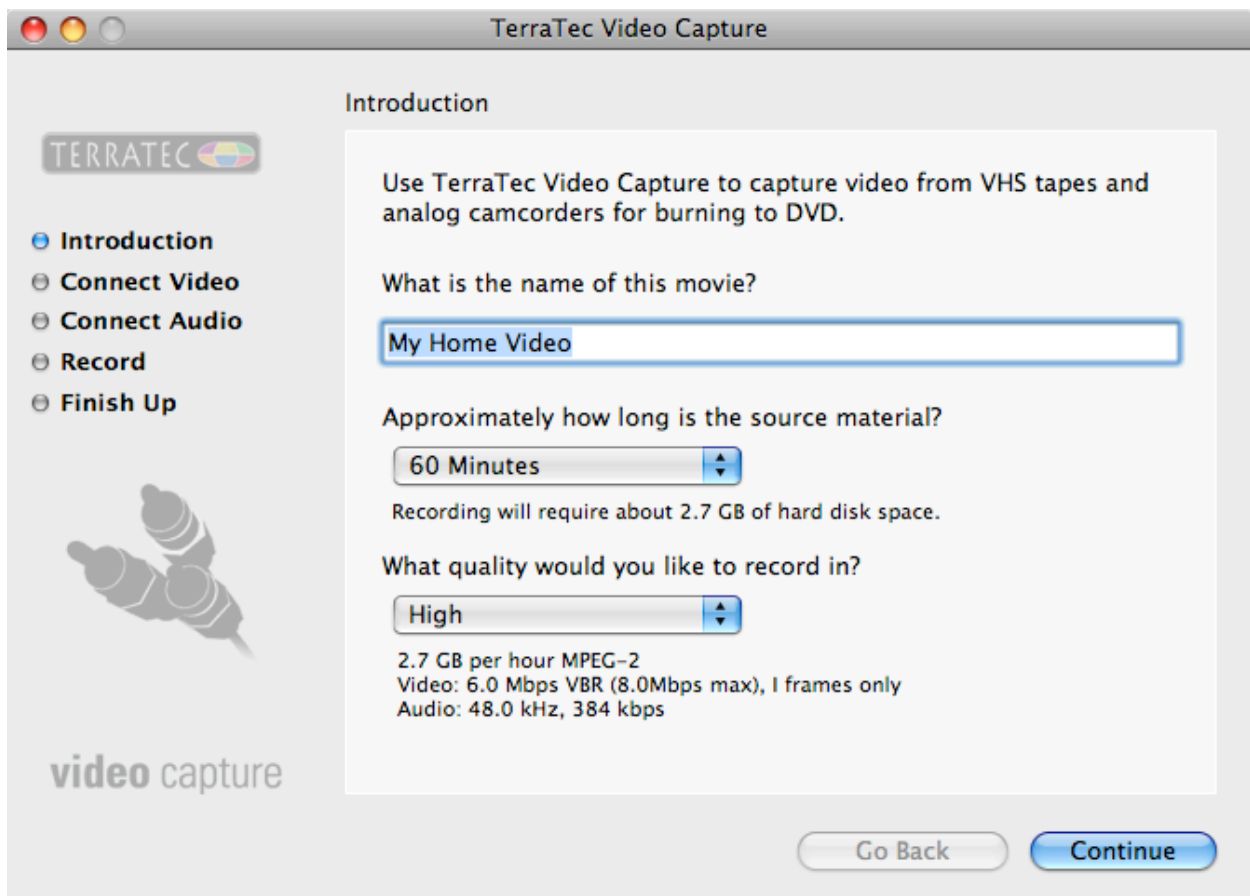
System Requirements

TerraTec Video Capture requires a Macintosh computer with an Intel Core Duo processor, QuickTime 7.6 or later, iTunes 8.1 or later, and Mac OS X 10.5.8 or later. **We recommend installing all software and security updates.**

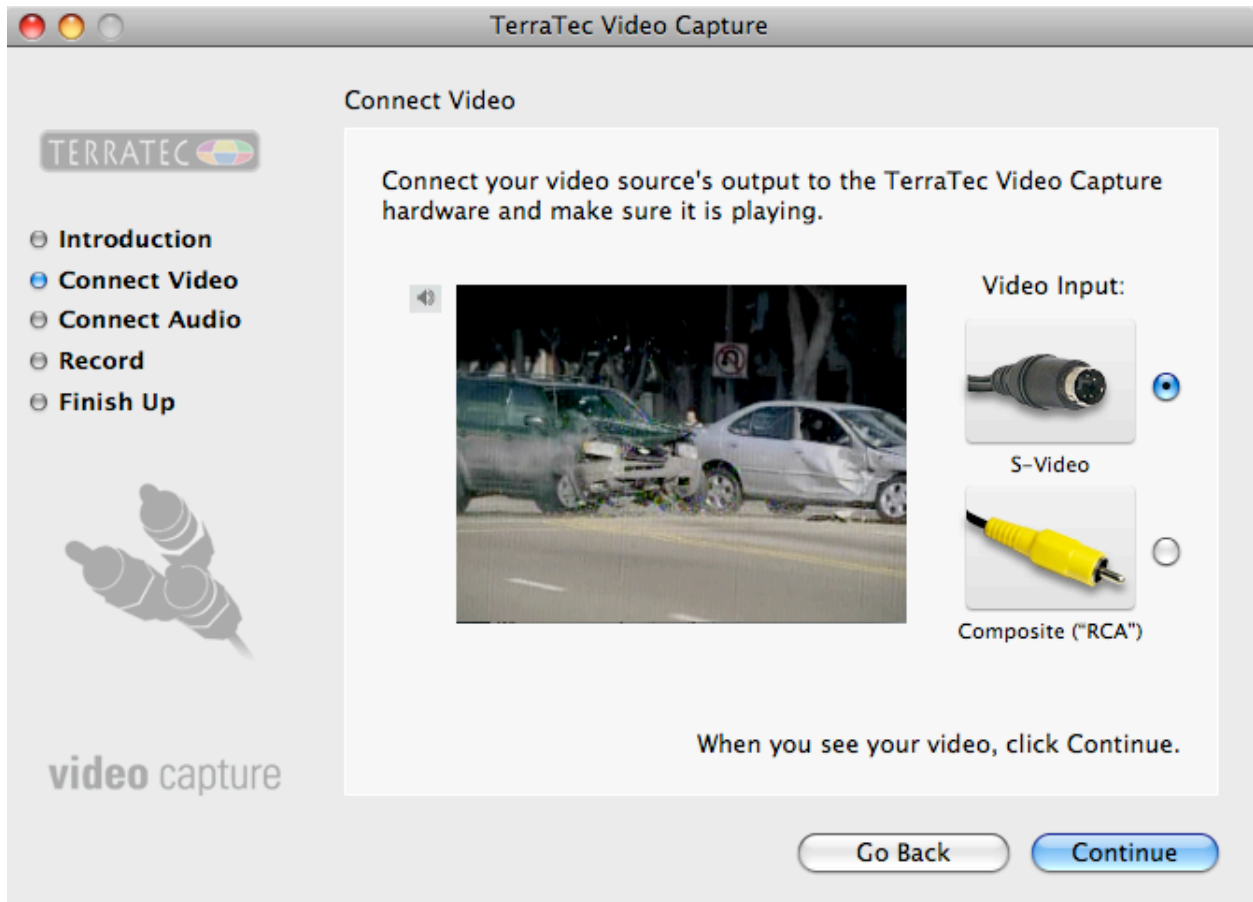
Usage

Connect the TerraTec Video Capture hardware to your Macintosh and launch the TerraTec Video Capture application. A video capture assistant will walk you through the entire process of capturing video and transferring it to your selected destination.

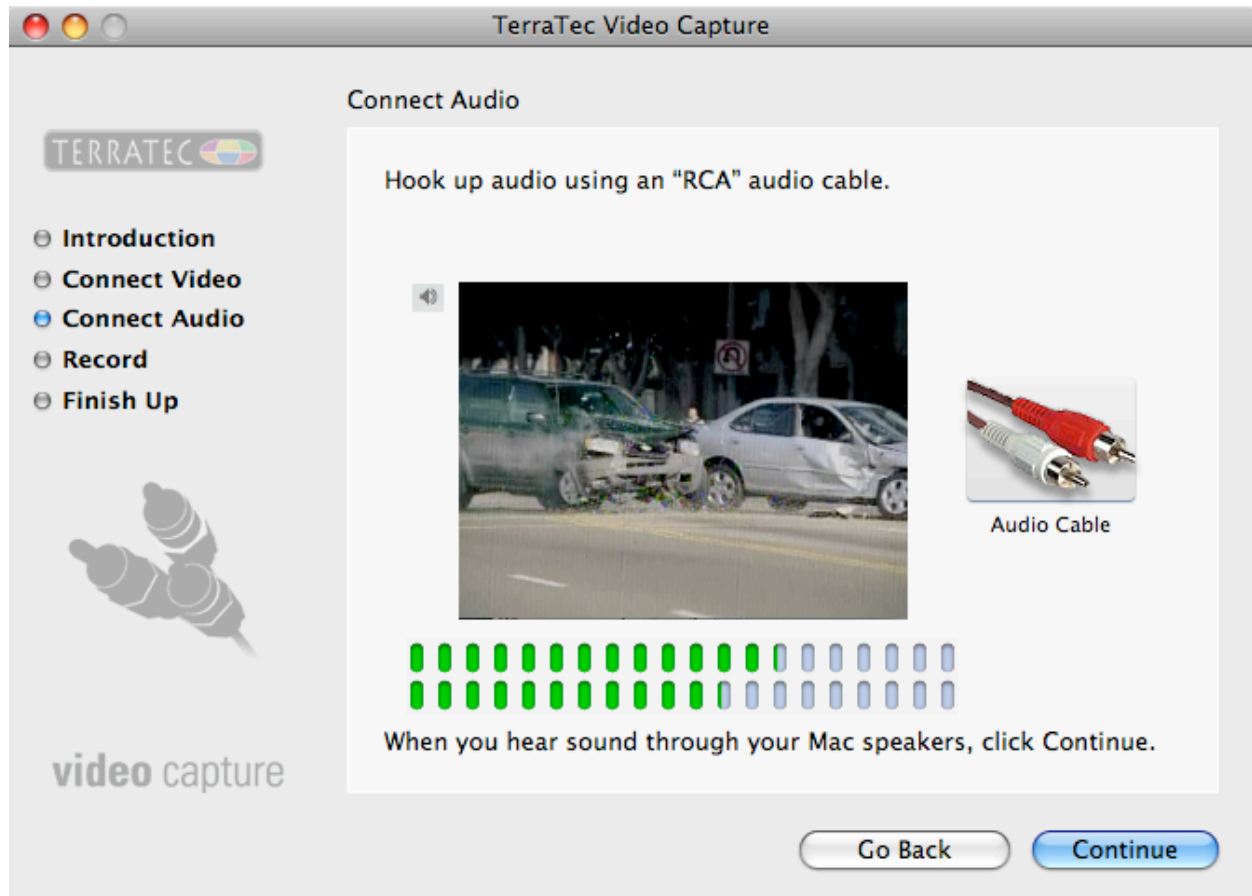
In the first screen that appears, you'll be asked to name your movie, and specify its approximate duration.



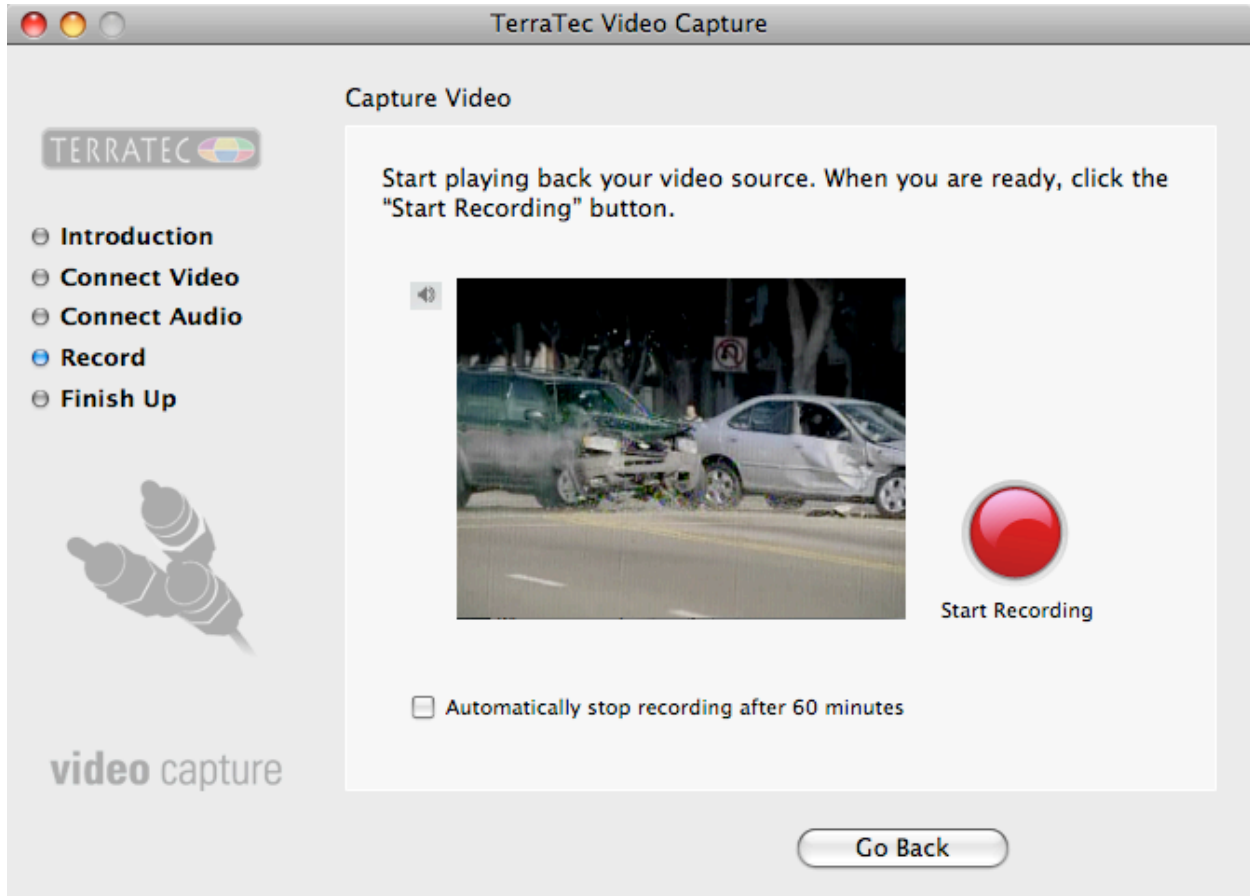
Next, start playing back your video source and connect its output to the TerraTec Video Capture. Choose the appropriate input (either the S-Video or Composite "RCA") using the radio buttons until you see your video playing.



Next, connect your video source's audio outputs to TerraTec Video Capture. Click "Continue" once you hear sound through your Mac's speakers. If the volume is too loud, the meter will turn red, which is a sign of distortion. It is recommended to adjust the volume so that the meter does not turn red.



Finally, set your video source to the beginning and start playing it back. Click the “Start Recording” button. When you are done, click the “Stop Recording” button, or let the TerraTec Video Capture software stop recording automatically.



The TerraTec Video Capture software saves the captured movie to the Movies folder.

After the video has been saved, you can select whether to play your video in QuickTime, edit it with iMovie or send it to Toast.

If you would like to create a new recording, simply press the "New Recording" button and the assistant will start over from the beginning. If you are finished recording, press the "Quit" button to exit the assistant.
